Minutes

CALL TO ORDER at 7:15pm by Jack Kirk. Members present Denzil McGill, Denzey McGill, Kathy Kirk, Jack Kirk, Marcella Kirk, Chris Kirk, Kyle Hallum, Shane Kirk, Jason Tipton, and Steve Creecy. Jack made a statement we were meeting under the Open Meeting Law.

Motion by Chris Kirk to approve tonights agenda and minutes from 3-05 meeting, seconded by Steve Creecy. All in attendance voting in favor.

Secretary Treasurer Report was given by Steve Creecy. See report attached. Discussion on report. Shane Kirk made a motion to accept the report and Jason Tipton seconded. All in attendance voting in favor. Chris Kirk made a motion and Shane Kirk seconded to pay bills as presented to Sec-Treasurer. All in favor.

Chief Report given by Jack Kirk, this past Fire Chief Meeting had a very low attendance of 7 departments and it takes 8 to have a quorum, so no voting or business could take place. We have had 40 runs to date. There is a special check presentation on Friday 4-29-05 at the Love County Fair Building inviting all Fire Departments and their families for dinner and presentation on up coming legislation that will affect the departments. May- Wild land Fire Training OSU Trainer-Need 20 persons committed to attend this or we can not book them to come. Please be thinking if you *will commit to this training. In June all department want to get trucks together and have training on hooking them up and pumping water so all department know how this can happen on a scene. In July Fire Academy A starts again.*

Recent Incidents: Jason shared his experience on the house fire in Marietta with 15-20 people turning out and only 3-4 doing the work. He also feels that some kind of competition is going on down south causing a problem it seems to him. Chris Kirk discussed what to do initially on all structure fires. Jack discussed West End Accident - Collision on Mud Creek Bridge, discussed No bunker gear was used by most and could not distinguish fire fighters from civilians and by standers. Jack also discussed the Washington Park house where there was a heater on fire and they paged Marietta and Medics, then Shady Dale. Marietta did not respond to this fire and Shady Dale got on scene and put the fire out.

Old Business consisted of the Fish Fry coming up First Friday in June on the 3rd from 4:40pm to 7:30pm. We are adding a Pie Auction this year to the Fish Fry at 6:30 with Michael Sampson to be the auctioneer. Chris reported on the Pumper Microphone he checked about it would cost approximately \$400.00 No action taken on this item. Payment \$2000.00 made on the Tanker leaving \$5300.00 plus interest. AED Back in service. FEMA Grant 2004 discussion on satisfying this grant with remaining tickets from Casco on the bags we ordered and the shields for helmets but no action on this was taken as our budget could not permit at this time. Jack will take care of the expense on these items.

REAP 2005 Report – Discussion on what we could do with the \$5000.00 awarded on this grant. Jack is to call SODA and see if we can buy accessories that go with Structure Gear. No action needed.

New Business: Kathy Kirk has put together a letter of request to Governor Bill Annoatubby from the Chickasaw Nation for a Wild land truck to see if they will donate funds for us to purchase 2 at a request of \$50,000 each – total request from them for this project is \$100,000.

Open Forum: Fish Fry at Falconhead Saturday at 5:00pm. Chris says we need to wash all our trucks and if anyone has some free time come on up and clean one up.

Training: Chris presented the command sheet and went over in depth. It will be on all the clip boards in each vehicle and can be used for Incident Command Management of scene with documented information. We trained in depth.
