

GREENVILLE – OVERBROOK
VFD MEETING
9-29-05
MINUTES

Members in attendance: Chief Jack Kirk, Marcella Kirk, Steve Creecy, Danny Hicks, Shane Kirk, Jason Tipton, Denzey McGill, Kathy Kirk and Denzil McGill came later.

Chief Kirk called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. at the firehouse.

Chief Kirk requested the approval of the minutes for 7-28-05 and 8-25-05. Steve Creecy made the motion and Danny Hicks seconded.

Steve Creecy gave Secretary & Treasurer report. The dept. had \$6,018.23, \$1,600.00 was needed for the new brush truck. In October the dept. should receive operation money along with payment for the Tank battery fire in Bomar which has not been receive as of yet, also Memberships are getting ready to be sent out. Chief Kirk advised that a payment was due on the Peterbilt, and ask that \$1,000.00 + interest be paid. Shane made a motion to make the payment, Jason & Denzey seconded. All present voted in favor and the motion carried. None opposed.

Recent Incidents: Jason and Chief Kirk responded to Total for a gas leak.

Old Business:

- Brush truck was ordered and will take 4-6 weeks to receive, also a docking fee of \$100.00 - \$125.00.
- Marcella reported that grant money of \$30,400.00 was in the bank account and that \$1,600.00 was needed by the dept. to matched the funds of 5% for the grant.
- 11-5-05 is the Toy run, Doug has everything but pop donated.
- Chief Kirk and Danny are going to work on lights for the small tanker.
- 2006 Reap Grant has been submitted to purchase SCBA'S
- Chris and Danny greased and changed oil in the pumper.

New Business:

- Fall Festival was discussed and all were in agreement not to participate this year.
- Workday to be set when the new brush truck comes in. Danny invited department to their shop for workday and fish fry.
- Chris was in charge of checking on lights but was not present to report.
- Chief Kirk is checking on the bed, radio and siren may be taken out of one of the old trucks until new ones can be purchased.
- Marcella made the motion to reimburse money to those First Responders who pass the National Registry test. (approximately \$300.00 for books) Steve Creecy seconded the motion. All approved and the motion carried. None opposed.

Open Forum:

Marcella asked that we report any problems with equipment or vehicles to the Chief, so it can be taken out of service. Also, the Rescue truck was out of brake fluid so check it needs to be checked on a regular basis.

Denzil was checking on a WalMart gift card to help raise money for the new brush truck.

Kathy discussed the request to Chickasaw Nation for a new brush truck. Linda Briggs advised that it takes time and she would check on it to see where we were.

Jason asked about the progress of the safe house. Chief Kirk advised that the Love County Fire Association and Thackerville fire dept. was purchasing the safe house, which is used to teach children about fire safety.

Kathy will contact Sam Barrick about the safe house through Farm Bureau.

Contact Denzey and he will add to our website. Marcella is emailing pictures to him to post on our site.

Marcella discussed the Leadership Love County Class, in which she and Kathy are a part of. The class project being discussed was a Countywide Communication System.

Shane inquired about fire safety training with the Greenville School. Chief Kirk advised that we needed to contact the school and check it out.
